HB 1227 Metcalf Relating to changing the eligibility for community supervision of a person convicted of possession or promotion of child pornography.

HB 1743 Leach Relating to allowing certain inmates to apply for supplemental nutrition assistance program benefits to be provided at the time of discharge or release.

HB 1747 Leach Relating to the consequences of a criminal conviction on a person's eligibility for an occupational license.

HB 1832 Kacal Relating to authorizing the payment to employees of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice for vacation leave.

HB 1914 Kacal Relating to compensatory time accrued by an employee of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
