SB 23 Huffman | et al. Relating to increasing the minimum term of imprisonment and changing the eligibility for community supervision and parole for certain felony offenses in which a firearm is used or exhibited and to certain consequences on conviction of certain offenses.

SB 338 Hinojosa | et al. Relating to the use of hypnotically induced statements in a criminal trial.

SB 402 Whitmire | et al. Relating to the preference given by trial courts to hearings and trials for murder and capital murder offenses.

SB 947 King Relating to creating a criminal offense for damaging certain critical infrastructure facilities and providing for the prosecution of that conduct as manslaughter in certain circumstances; increasing a criminal penalty.

SB 1518 King Posting Rule Suspended Relating to the establishment of a terrorist offender registry and to the supervision of those terrorist offenders; creating criminal offenses related to terrorism.

SB 1653 Huffman | et al. Relating to the punishment for the offense of promotion of prostitution.

SB 1717 Zaffirini Relating to the prosecution of the offense of stalking. HJR 99 Stucky | et al. Posting Rule Suspended Proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the denial of bail to certain persons arrested for an offense resulting in the death of or serious bodily injury to a person younger than 18 years of age.

HB 3197 Frazier Posting Rule Suspended Relating to definition change for certain customer data, communications, and other information held in electronic storage in this state and other states by providers of electronic communications services and remote computing services.
