SB 3074 Birdwell
Relating to communications between the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the governor, the lieutenant governor, or a member of the legislature.

HB 49 Darby | et al. SP: Perry
Relating to the treatment and beneficial use of fluid oil and gas waste and related material, including a limitation on liability for that treatment or use.

HB 2440 Curry | et al. SP: Parker
Relating to the authority of a state agency or the state's air quality state implementation plan to impose certain restrictions with respect to a motor vehicle, including a motor vehicle powered by an engine.

HB 3556 Vasut | et al. SP: Middleton
Relating to measures to minimize the impact on migratory birds of structures exceeding a certain height in certain counties containing National Wildlife Refuges and in adjacent counties.

HB 3619 Dean SP: Zaffirini
Relating to the rights and liabilities of the owner of the surface estate of the tract of land on which a well to be plugged or replugged by the Railroad Commission of Texas is located.

HB 3866 Landgraf SP: Sparks
Relating to the installation and operation of intermediate bulk container recycling facilities; authorizing a fee.

HB 4042 Morales, Eddie SP: Zaffirini
Relating to the applicability of certain safety provisions and regulatory fees administered by the Railroad Commission of Texas to gas distribution pipelines.

HB 4112 Landgraf SP: Birdwell
Relating to the disposal or storage of high-level radioactive waste.

HB 4271 Gerdes SP: Kolkhorst
Relating to public meetings held by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on requests for authorization to operate a composting facility.

HB 4413 Paul | et al. SP: Hancock
Relating to mass balance attribution of renewable biomass feedstocks used to produce renewable chemicals.

HB 4426 Darby SP: Zaffirini
Relating to permits issued by the Railroad Commission of Texas for commercial surface disposal facilities.

HB 5033 Bell, Keith | et al. SP: Flores
Relating to the authority of this state to implement a motor vehicle emissions inspection and maintenance program.
